SUPPLIES:

- Basket Tops/Basket Bottoms/Pinwheels: 13 fat quarters
- Side and Corner Triangles: 1 yard
- Sashing Strips: 3/3 yard
- Backing: 3 yards
- Border: ½ yard
- Batting
- Binding: ½ yard





Read through the complete pattern instructions before starting.

FLOWER BASKETS


Cut 13 floral fabrics into triangles 12 1/2" x 8 %" x 8 %".




For each basket bottom, cut six rectangles 2 1/2" x 4 1/2". Use 3 fabrics (2 rectangles each) per basket bottom.




- a/ Sew rectangles 1, 2, and 3 together. end to end, right sides together.
 - b/ Sew rectangles 3 and 1 together, end to end, right sides together.
 - c/ Arrange three rows of rectangles.




Sew rows together, staggering seam lines.




5 With right sides together, sew a floral top to a basket bottom. Flip the basket block over and press seams towards bottom of basket.




Position block on cutting mat and trim basket bottom to form a block measuring 8 ½" x 8 ½".




Construct 13 basket blocks on point.




8 Each pinwheel requires two squares (2 ¾" x 2 ¾"), each from different fabrics. Layer squares right sides together. Cut in half diagonally twice.




- 9 a/ Without separating the cut pieces, sew along the long edges of each triangle set.
 - b/ Open and press to dark sides.
 - c/ Clip dog ears.




- 10 a/ Arrange sets into pinwheel block.
 - b/ With right sides together, sew square 1 to square 2. Press seam.
 - c/ Sew square 3 to square 4. Press seam.



- a/ Sew Unit 1-2 to Unit 3-4 to complete pinwheel block.
 - b/ Press seam open.
 - c/ Trim pinwheel to measure 2 ½" x 2 ½".



12 Construct 24 Pinwheel Blocks.




SASHING STRIPS

13 Cut 36 (2 ½" x 8 ½") strips of one fabric.



SIDE & CORNER Setting Triangles

- 14 a/ Cut 2 squares (15 %" x 15 %").
 - b/ Cut squares in half diagonally twice, You will have 8 side setting triangles.
 - c/ Cut 2 squares (9 3/8" x 9 3/8").
 - d/ Cut each square in half diagonally once. You will have 4 corner setting triangles.




ASSEMBLING THE QUILT

Lay out and arrange quilt pieces. Follow Assembling Chart and join pieces together in diagonal rows first, EXCLUDING all side and corner triangles. Press seams in one direction, alternating directions in each row.

HINT: When pressing the seams, you will alternate directions in order to make the seams less bulky. When the rows are lined up, the seams should line up as well.




Join Row A to Row B. Now add side triangles to the sides of the combined rows. Repeat this step for Rows C-D, Rows H-I, and Rows J-K. (Rows E-F-G are discussed in Step 17.)



Join Rows E-F-G.
DO NOT SEW ON CORNER TRIANGLES!




Join all rows together. Press seams. Join 4 corner triangles to quilt corners. Press seams. Quilt top should measure 46" x 46"



ADDING THE BORDER


19 a/ Cut 2 strips (2 ½" x 46"). b/ Cut 2 strips (2 ½" x 50").



HINT: You will have to piece border strips to get 46" lengths.

a/ Sew 46" strips to right and left sides of quilt. Press seams towards border.

b/ Sew 50"strips on the top and bottom of the quilt. Press seams towards border.



Layer and quilt as desired. Bind with complimentary fabric.



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
